Claremont Showground new Home to WA's Caravanning Lifestyle Super Show

The Perth Caravan and Camping Show. WA's fastest growing outdoor lifestyle and product event is moving to the Claremont Showgrounds in 2008. It will be held from Thursday 13th to Monday 17th March.

Caravan Industry Association WA (CIAWA) President, Richard Raven, said the event had outgrown other available venues and was now ideal to stage at Perth's biggest exhibition venue, the Claremont Showground.

"Over the last three years the number of exhibitors has increased considerably, not only in numbers but in the range of products and models they bring to the Show, so we have been requiring more and more space."

"Public transport, parking, convenience for visitors and suitable layout and infrastructure for exhibitors have been very challenging for us, so we are very excited that they have now come together."

Claremont Showgrounds will bring a whole new look to the Show. There are indoor pavilions, large grassed areas, hardstand areas, a dedicated theatre for seminars, and numerous catering outlets.

There is also ample free parking with easy access by train to the Claremont Showground station and a number of entry gates.

"We see this as being the 'home' of the Perth Caravan and Camping Show, which I think everyone will be pleased about," said Richard Raven.

Last year over 40,000 visitors attended the 5-day Super Show.

Royal Agricultural Society CEO Martin Molony said that the caravan industry's Caravan & Camping Show was a welcome addition to the country and outdoor lifestyle events for which the Claremont Showground was noted.

"Many of our agricultural and rural communities rely on caravanners and motorhomes to boost their local economy and there are many amongst them who also move around the country enjoying the lifestyle."

"So there is a very good synergy between the two organizations."
